Yes, a billion spectators witnessed Mario Götze's golden goal. The outstanding Paul Ripke however, was the only photographer allowed to be close to the world's best players, also in the moment of their final victory. No other photographer was able to capture the private and intimate atmosphere amongst the participants like he did.

Get exactly this feeling for your home! The DFB and photographer Paul Ripke have commissioned Middelkamp KG to create eleven exhibition sets at their finest in the company's exclusive workshop in Bocholt. Each set consists of 27 reportage pictures, 27 portraits and a hand- gilded font plate with the exhibition theme "One Night in Rio".

Kitchen, conference room, office, hobby room, living room... Hang up one of these wonderfully framed limited works wherever you like and feel like a champion!

The framed portraits are works of unprecedented quality. Each national team player as well as the four coaches were caught on camera by photographer Paul Ripke. Using a Phase One, which is a professional camera with 60 million pixels and a 80mm Schneider - Kreuznach optics, each shot was created in skilled precision. The focal plane lies exactly on the eyes; the tip of the nose and the ears are already blurred due to perfectly selected depth of field. The digital images were printed on special paper by the use of lightfast pigment ink. An unsurpassable quality. The works are "floatingly" framed by two glazed wooden strips. The surface is protected by the best museum glass, which is glare-free and provides special UV protection. An exclusive certificate signed by the photographer is enclosed. Moreover each portrait was numbered on the front, in the right hand corner in an unobtrusive way. All in all: "excellent collector - quality". Unique in strictly limited numbers: Worldwide only eleven copies per image.
